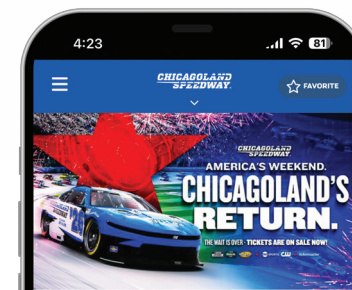

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

- RV load-in begins Thursday, July 2, at 9 AM.
- To access the check-in area, use Gate 6 off Laraway Rd. For safety reasons, please do not park on public roads prior to the opening of gate 6.
- Lakeside Campground will check in at the campground entrance located on East Rd.
- All other campgrounds will load at the RV Check In located on Speedway Ridge Ln off East Rd.
- RVs arriving after 11 PM will be asked to wait until 8 AM the next morning to be inspected and allowed into their campgrounds. This is for safety reasons and to make sure all campers are thoroughly inspected and processed.
- Campers are allowed to remain on Chicagoland Speedway property until noon on Monday, July 6.
- **Campers will be held up to 2 hours post-checked flag on Sunday to allow vehicles to exit**

REMINDERS

- Infield admission wristbands are not valid for grandstand admission.
- Dogs are allowed in all campgrounds, including the infield. Service Animals are allowed anywhere on property including the ticket gates, grandstands and infield garage areas. Owners must keep dogs on a leash 6 feet or shorter or keep the pets in the RV. Use designated areas for walking and playing with your dog in the campground. Pick up after your pet and properly dispose of waste. You are responsible for any personal injury or property damage caused by your dog. Please ensure that your dog does not interfere with other guests (e.g., aggression, noise, waste). Problems arising from pet behavior might result in removal from the campground and Chicagoland Speedway property.
- Motorcycles are allowed in all campgrounds.
- Motorcycles must be parked within the campsite.
- "Cruising" of motorcycles is prohibited.
- If you need ice, water fill or pump outs, contact your Campground Ambassador assistance.

RULES

- Fire lanes must be open at all times. Vehicles blocking lanes established by Chicagoland Speedway will be towed at the owner's expense.
- Bicycles are allowed in all campgrounds and Infield Campgrounds must walk bicycles out/in through the tunnel walk lane.
- Bicycles are not permitted in Champions Park or the midway areas.
- Quiet time at Chicagoland Speedway will be enforced from midnight to 6 AM. All internal and external sound systems must be maintained at a reasonable level and turned off during quiet time.
- No open fires are allowed on Chicagoland Speedway property. Only barbecues, camping stoves, and fire pits will be permitted and must be a minimum of 10 feet from any vehicle or structure. All fires must be attended at all times.
- Chicagoland Speedway is a family-oriented facility, offensive signs, public intoxication, and profanity will not be tolerated.
- State and county health department rules must be obeyed.
- Do not dump waste or wastewater onto the ground or into holes on Chicagoland Speedway property.
- Illegal activities or actions that violate the rules and policies of Chicagoland Speedway are considered grounds for immediate removal from the premises.
- Tickets, passes, and admissions may be confiscated and are non-refundable.
- Chicagoland Speedway is committed to providing a safe and enjoyable family environment for all guests in attendance. We ask for your cooperation by adhering to all Chicagoland Speedway rules and policies while respecting the rights of other guests. Chicagoland Speedway reserves the right to change rules at any time.
- Working carbon monoxide monitor required.
- No obscene or indecent language and imagery, including Confederate flags.

TYPE OF RV PERMITTED

- RV's, 5th wheels and Travel trailers are allowed in all campgrounds.
- Tents are only allowed in Lakeside campground

ADMISSION AND VEHICLE POLICIES

- Wristbands are required to access infield campgrounds, Skyline Terrace and Speedway Ridge.
- Extra wristbands are available at a box office.
- Wristband limits per site do apply
- Each campsite includes one vehicle pass. Additional vehicles must purchase an overnight parking pass and park in Lot G located near camper check-in.
- All vehicles must fit within the 20' x 45' space.
- Motorhomes, RVs, campers, or any other self-contained vehicle admitted with a reserved site admission will not be eligible for pass-out or re-entry.

RESTRICTED ITEMS

- Glass bottles are prohibited.
- Sleeping tents are not allowed on RV camping spots and are only allowed in Lakeside Campground.
- Temporary scaffolding is prohibited.
- Ladders and platforms must be permanently attached to the vehicle.
- No platforms more than 12 inches above the roof line are allowed.
- No weapons of any type (e.g., firearms, sporting knives, swords) are permitted. Fireworks, Super Soakers, water balloon launchers, spotlights, laser pointers, drones, sky lanterns, or other items deemed dangerous by Chicagoland Speedway to guests, staff, or competitors are strictly prohibited and will be confiscated.
- Flags or banners rising above the roofline must be taken down prior to the race.
- No signage or advertising is permitted on any vehicle without written approval.
- Chicagoland Speedway policy prohibits e-bikes, e-scooters, ATVs, dune buggies, private golf carts, riding barstools, riding coolers, Segways, etc.
